

Back-to-School Number Matching Game

Directions: Print the following pages on construction paper. Laminate the pages and cut the apples out. On a table, turn the apples over so that the words cannot be read. Have teams (or individuals) take turns turning over two apples at a time. If the one apple matches the other, the team (or individual) may try to make another match. For example, a match is made if one apple says "two" and the other apple says " ● ● ". The team (or individual) with the most matches wins. This makes a great center activity after you've taught numbers.
